
CHAMPAGNES

1. **CHAMPAGNE THIENNOT, BRUT NV** £30.95
Lots of fruit and age and, above all, a tight rein on the acidity. Used as the House Champagne in Marco Pierre White's restaurants.
 2. **CHAMPAGNE VICTOR ROSE, BRUT NV** £34.95
Salmon colour delicate bubbles with a structured aroma and red fruit flavours.
 3. **CHAMPAGNE DRAPPIER Cuvée Exception 2003** £39.50
Vintage Champagne is only made in the best years. This 2000 reflects what a superb vintage this is.
 4. **BOLLINGER Special Cuvée Brut NV** £54.50
Matured for four years after the second fermentation in the bottle, plus at least one further year, this champagne is unashamedly full of character with plenty of body, depth and length.
 5. **LAURENT PERRIER BRUT ROSE NV** £71.50
Traditional Rosé Champagne house using the skin contact method the same as Drappier, to produce the Champagne in the traditional quality manner.
 6. **DOM PERIGNON 2000** £110.50
Rich, creamy, complex flavours, produced from the best grapes in Champagne.

SPARKLING WINES

7. **CUVEE DE L'ECUSSON BRUT** £18.75
*Full, fresh and fruity. Tremendous breadth and flavour with a classic style.
A great Champagne alternative.*
9. **MASCHIO DEI CAVELIERI PROSCECCO DI VALDOBBIADENE** £18.75
Refined with soft bubbles and fruity flavours, trendy and elegant.
10. **TRUMPETER MALBEC/ROSE BRUT** £18.75
Extremely distinctive and intense sparkling rose, with aromas of cherries and strawberries.
11. **TRUMPETER CHARDONNAY BRUT** £18.75
Displays delicate aromas of green apple, combined with attractive toasty notes.

CRISP, DRY WHITE WINES

20. **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2007 Touraine, Loire, France** £17.45
*Fresh and crisp from a superb family estate and a very good vintage.
Elegant floral tones that would match delicate food flavours and grilled
fish dishes.*
22. **SANCERRE 2007 Domaine de Grande Perrieres** £24.25
*A fine 'steely' Sancerre with all the delicate flavour of the Sauvignon grape
a very open and inviting white wine.*
23. **PETIT CHABLIS 2007 Château de Maligny, Jean Durup** £24.45
*From a selected vineyard site within the Château de Maligny vineyard, this clean,
flinty Chablis has incredible concentration of flavour.*
24. **INTEGER CHARDONNAY 2005, South Africa** £26.45
*Fresh, lemony aromas combined with a delicate smokiness for a well-balanced
Chardonnay with a soft finish. An outstanding wine.*

FRUITY, DISTINCTIVE WHITE WINES

30. **TRUMPETER CLASSIC TORRONTES 2006, Argentina** £16.95
An intense and distinctive wine with aromas of peaches, jasmine and rose and refreshing citrus notes.
32. **PINOT GRIGIO Delle Venezie, Sartori 2007, Verona Italy** £17.95
Pale straw in colour, this Pinot Grigio combines a clean floral bouquet with a full palate and a touch of exotic spice.
33. **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2008 Bush Vine, Darling Cellars, South Africa** £18.95
Tropical flavours on the nose with passion fruit and guava. These flavours together with hints of grassiness are carried through generously to the palate with a zesty long aftertaste.
34. **GEWURZTRAMINER 2005 Materne Haegelin, Alsace, France** £20.45
An intensely perfumed, spicy white from Alsace with a typically aromatic character, full of flavour. The wine is elegant and feminine reflecting the personality of the wine maker.

MORE POWERFUL, FULL-BODIED WHITE WINES

40. **MACON FUISSE Domaine Thibert, Burgundy, France 2006** £23.45
*Highly recommended by the Proprietor. This is White Burgundy at its best.
All the flavours come together in harmony, wonderful Chardonnay fruit with hints
of butter and vanilla. The Thibert have been making Burgundy for generations and
practise makes perfect, as is the case here.*
41. **SAUVIGNON BLANC, Terrace View, New Zealand 2008** £24.50
*This wine has a layered structure of complex flavours of passion fruit and melon.
The wine finishes with a creamy texture with integrated and subtle nutty oak.*
42. **POUILLY VINZELLES Domaine Thibert, Burgundy 2006** £27.95
*From one of the lesser-known villages in the Maconnais, but this wine is everything
you would expect from white burgundy. A real find. Keep it to yourself.*
44. **CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE BLANC, Clos St Jean, Rhone, France 2006** £44.95
This 2006 vintage has copious pear and honeyed citrus in a medium-bodied style.
45. **MEURSAULT, Domaine Bouzereau 2006** £45.45
*Rich, buttery, white Burgundy from one of the most prestigious villages in the Côtes
de Beaune, a special choice, this is ideally suited to duck or the richer-tasting fish or
chicken dishes.*

LIGHTER, FRUITY, RED WINES

Bottle

50. **COTES DU RHONE, Haut Colombier 2007** £15.45
Medium to light-bodied, smooth, with violets and peppery fruit, a good easy to drink style with light berry fruit flavours and soft tannins.
51. **INDOMITA, PINOT NOIR, Casablanca, Chile 2008** £17.95
Classical, New World Pinot Noir, ripe berry fruit with a gentle hint of Eucalyptus and firm but balanced structure on the finish. A more complex style with undertones of the terroir showing on the finish, which creates a neo Burgundian style wine.
52. **BROUILLY, Domaine Mondenet 2007** £20.95
Delicate, soft and appealing Cru Beaujolais from this consistently top-quality Domaine. Best described as summer pudding in a glass. The wine maker is a larger than life character and is reflected in this wine.
53. **FLEURIE, Domaine Bouronière 2006** £24.45
Probably the most popular of all the Beaujolais Crus, soft and elegant with a velvety finish, this is a family estate, dedicated to improving quality and the fact that the estate has won many awards is proof of this.
54. **FLEURIE, Cuvee Prestige 2004** £27.95
The Gamay grape variety that the wine is made from bestows velvetyness, elegance, and fruity aromas. This spicy wine full of personality is excellent with full flavoured dishes.

MEDIUM-BODIED, BALANCED, RED WINES

60. **TRUMPETER CLASSIC Malbec/Merlot 2007, Argentina** £16.95
An elegant red wine well balanced and easy to drink.
63. **CABERNET SAUV/MERLOT, Ashton Cellars, South Africa 2006** £20.95
Cabernet Sauvignon provides the structure and dark fruit and Merlot the fresh fruity character. A character wine with a good wood/fruit balance.
64. **BODEGAS UGARTE CRIANZA, Rioja, Spain 2005** £21.95
Twelve months in oak, twelve months ageing in the bottle, richly-flavoured and attractively oaky.
65. **CABERNET MERLOT, Terrace View, New Zealand 2005** £21.95
Blackcurrant and spice aromas with a hint of almond and truffles. Lots of fruit emphasis with berries and plums combined with delicate savoury characters and fine tannins.
66. **CABERNET /SHIRAZ, Dixons Peak, South Africa 2006** £24.95
Deep Purple centre with a pink rim describes the youthfulness of the wine. Black Cherry and Raspberry aromas denote its fruitiness which is rounded off by subtle aromas of pencil shavings and spicy notes from the French Oak, a quality Organic wine.

BORDEAUX “CLARET”

Bottle

70. **CHATEAU LANDAT AC Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc 2002** £20.45
From this family estate, a rarity in Bordeaux, a classical Médoc wine with more Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend, giving wonderful blackcurrant fruit complexity from the gravel soils and fine integrated tannins from 20% new oak.
71. **CHATEAU LA TONNELLE, AC Haut Médoc, Cru Bourgeois 2005** £22.95
A smooth and fruity wine, with a delicate oaky taste. Predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon, soft tannins make this very pleasant drinking.
72. **CHATEAU LAPELLETRE, Grand Cru, St Emilion 2005** £35.50
Firm very oaky claret with ripe blackberry fruit, This wine is 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, a third of the volume aged in new oak casks in old cellars hewn into the rock besides the chateau.
74. **CHATEAU GRAND PUY LACOSTE, AC 5ème Cru Classé Pauillac 1997** £54.25
Bordeaux, France
This Château extends over a splendid gravel bank, which accounts for the 75% Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend, its facets usually include a rich, polished, concentrated taste with noble tannins and wonderful fruit concentration, notably blackcurrant cherry and plum.

MORE FULL-BODIED RED WINES

80. **SHIRAZ, Black Granite, Darling Cellars, South Africa 2007** £20.95
*A medium bodied wine displaying wild berries, spice and cloves on the nose.
A creamy palate with flavours of raspberry, supported by a soft tannin structure.*
81. **CARMENERE, Colchagua Valley 2007, Chile** £24.45
The wine displays the distinctive aromas of the variety with flavours of spice, black tea and tobacco intergrated by a long barrel-aging of 12 months in French and American oak.
82. **PINOT NOIR, Delta Vineyard, New Zealand 2007** £25.95
This wine has a good depth of vibrant colour, with a perfumed nose that mingles aromas of Black Cherries with a floral note giving way to supple yet vibrant fruit on the palate
84. **MALBEC, Felipe Rutini 2005, Argentina** £29.95
Malbec from La Consulta is known for its explosive aromas and smooth tannins.
85. **CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE, Clos St Jean, Rhone, France, 2001** £30.95
Rich, full of flavour, a classic example of quality Chateauf, from one of the best vineyard sites, made by the Maurels who have been making wines from the Clos St Jean vineyard for generations.
86. **GEVREY CHAMBERTIN, Domaine Rousseau, Burgundy, France 2000** £46.95
For the lover of fine red burgundy this rich and elegant wine comes from one of the leading growers in the region, well worth the price of admission!

ROSE WINES

87. **ROSE D'ANJOU, France 2007** £14.95
Almost medium dry, salmon pink in colour. This wine has delightful fruit flavours and aromas.
88. **SLOWINE, South Africa 2007** £17.40
*Lovely bright pink colour with a fresh fragrant nose of ripe strawberries & ripe cherries.
Crisp dry & refreshing flavours, long dry & fruity finish. Just great for Summer Evenings.
A superb South African Rose.*
89. **PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH, Italy 2006** £17.95
A delicate pink colour, this elegant wine from Sartori has crisp, clean summer fruit flavours on the palate and a style that sits slightly on the sweeter side of off-dry. Incredibly versatile.

PUDDING WINES

90. **ESSENCIA ORANGE MUSCAT, USA, 2006** Half Bottle £16.95
Orange Marmalade, honey and citrus undertones add up to what can be described as a little sweetie.
91. **MUSCAT DE BEAUMES DE VENISE, Domaine Durban 2005** Half Bottle £16.95
Described by the famous wine critic Robert Parker, as one of the world's best dessert wines, rich, pineapple bouquet, honey and tropical fruits on the palate and a long, lingering finish.
92. **ELYSIUM BLACK MUSCAT, Quady Winery, USA 2007** Half Bottle £17.95
From Madera County in California, an aroma of roses with a berry-like taste, this is rich and full-flavoured and matches a variety of desserts, in particular, rich, chocolate dishes are suited best.
93. **PACHERENC RESERVE 2005** 50cl Bottle £18.95
An intense concentration, and a unique balance, between sweetness and acidity.

WHITE WINES

120. **RHEINHESSEN, Niersteiner Gutes Domtal (German)**
Full of grape flavours and fruit but with a delicate freshness on the finish.
121. **CONVIVIALE Pinot Grigio (Italian)**
A pleasantly fruity white wine, with a citrus Fruit bouquet.
122. **STONEMASON Un-wooded Chardonnay (Australian)**
Fragrant summer stone fruit aromas, carry through to a medium bodied palate.
123. **REINARES Vendimia (Spanish)**
A vibrant and refreshing wine with floral and fruit flavours.
124. **SANTA SERENA Sauvignon Blanc (Chilean)**
A fresh and crisp wine, full of tingling aromatics

RED WINES

126. **REINARES Tempranillo (Spain)**
Fresh aromas of red and violet fruits lead into flavours of berries, plums, spice and vanilla, all integrated with subtle sweet oak and a nice acidity and wrapped up with a long silky finish full of fruit.
127. **STONEMASON Shiraz (Australian)**
Exhibiting lifted aromas of vanillin oak and violets, this fruit driven full bodied wine has a spicy complexity
129. **ASHTON CELLARS Pinotage/Ruby Cabernet (South Africa)**
An unsmoked blend of Ruby Cabernet and Pinotage. Layered with plum, green pepper and fruity tannin.
130. **SIERRA GRANDE Merlot (Chilean)**
Rich warm red, crammed with weight fruit.
