MORE POWERFUL FULL-BODIED WHITE WINES

40. **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2010 Faultline, New Zealand** **£18.95**
This wine has a layered structure of complex flavours of passion fruit and melon. The wine finishes on a creamy texture integrated with subtle nutty oak.
41. **MACON FUISSE 2009 Domaine Thibert, Burgundy, France** **£24.55**
Highly recommended by the Proprietor. This is White Burgundy at its best. All the flavours come together in harmony, wonderful Chardonnay fruit with hints of butter and vanilla. The Thibert have been making Burgundy for generations and practise makes perfect, as is the case here.
42. **POUILLY VINZELLES 2007 Domaine Thibert, Burgundy, France** **£29.95**
From one of the lesser-known villages in the Maconnais, but this wine is everything you would expect from white burgundy. A real find. Keep it to yourself.
44. **MEURSAULT 2006 Domaine Bouzereau, France** **£47.95**
Rich, buttery, white Burgundy from one of the most prestigious villages in the Côtes de Beaune, a special choice, this is ideally suited to duck or the richer-tasting fish/chicken dishes.

LIGHTER FRUITY RED WINES

50. **COTES DU RHONE 2008/2009 Haut Colombier, France** £16.95
Medium to light-bodied, smooth, with violets and peppery fruit, a good easy to drink style with light berry fruit flavours and soft tannins.
51. **MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 2009 Marchesini, Italy** £17.95
Intense ruby red colour with violet on the nose. The flavour is soft and lightly tannic.
52. **FLEURIE 2009 Cru du Beaujolais, Jeanne Galette, France** £21.95
This soft, medium-bodied red is crammed with juicy cherry fruit flavours and aromas.
53. **BROUILLY 2009 Domaine Mondenet, France** £25.95
Delicate, soft and appealing Cru Beaujolais from this consistently top-quality Domaine. Best described as summer pudding in a glass. The wine maker is a larger than life character and this is reflected in his wine.

<p>61. MERLOT 2009 Apaltagua Gran Verano, Chile <i>The Gran Verano Merlot is a ruby red coloured wine and possesses fresh fruit aromas with a touch of cherry. It displays an elegant finish with soft, round tannins.</i></p>	£17.40

BORDEAUX “CLARET”

80. **CHATEAU LANDAT AC 2005 Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc** **£25.95**
From this family estate, a rarity in Bordeaux, a classical Médoc wine with more Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend, giving wonderful blackcurrant fruit complexity from the gravel soils and fine integrated tannins from 20% new oak.
81. **CHATEAU LA TONNELLE AC 2007 Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc** **£27.50**
A smooth and fruity wine, with a delicate oaky taste. Predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon, soft tannins make this very pleasant drinking.
82. **CHATEAU LAPELLETRE 2006 Grand Cru, St Emilion** **£37.95**
Firm very oaky claret with ripe blackberry fruit, This wine is 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, a third of the volume aged in new oak casks in old cellars hewn into the rock besides the chateau.
83. **CHATEAU Les Tourelles Longueville 1995 Pauillac-Medoc** **£55.95**
This was an excellent vintage in the region and this is drinking very well now. 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, cedar on the nose and sweet black fruit flavours on the palate.

<p>71. CARMENERE 2009 Apaltagua, Reserva, Chile <i>Wild purple in colour, showing flavours of red and black cherries with smooth tannins and a juicy finish.</i></p>	£19.95
<p>72. PINOT NOIR 2008/2009 Te Kairanga, New Zealand <i>A vibrant well balanced wine with lots of varietal characters. Soft and balanced with aromas of violets and cherries, silky tannins give this wine elegance and appeal.</i></p>	£25.95

Light Salmon in appearance and with fruit flavours including strawberry and peach.
89. **FRANSCHHOEK ROSE 2010, South Africa** £16.95
An attractive well-balanced Rose wine, gushing with rich red berry aromas and flavours.

PUDDING WINES

90. **ESSENCIA ORANGE MUSCAT 2008 USA** Half Bottle £17.95
Orange Marmalade, honey and citrus undertones add up to what can be described as a little sweetie.
91. **MUSCAT DE BEAUMES DE VENISE 2007 France** Half Bottle £17.95
