

## CHAMPAGNES

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- 1. BAUCHET CUVÉE ORIGINE Brut Champagne NV** £36  
The Bauchet Brut is crisp, fruity and very refreshing as it is made from the Pinot Noir grape. All of the grapes are grown in vineyards owned by the Bauchet family and, before bottling under their own label, these grapes were sold to Verve Clicquot.
- 2. BAUCHET PREMIER CRU 'Signature' Brut Champagne NV** £46  
A blend of 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir. Nice as an aperitif, but also has lovely richness and hints of brioche and biscuit in the mouth, which makes it a wonderful match for seafood and chicken.
- 3. BOLLINGER Special Cuvée Brut NV** £65  
Matured for four years after the second fermentation in the bottle, plus at least one further year, this champagne is unashamedly full of character with plenty of body, depth and length.
- 4. LAURENT PERRIER BRUT ROSE NV** £70  
Traditional Rose Champagne house using the skin contact method the same as Drappier, to produce the Champagne in the traditional quality manner.
- 5. DOM PERIGNON 2006 Vintage** £150  
Rich, creamy, complex flavours, produced from the best grapes in Champagne.

## SPARKLING WINES

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- 10. BACIO DELLA LUNA ROSE** £21  
An extra dry rose with a vibrant fruity nose, packed with red berry aromas. The palate is crisp with juicy red berry flavours and lovely bubbles.
- 11. PROSECCO, SAINT ORSOLA, BRUT NV** £24  
Light, crisp and refreshing with wonderful off dry stone fruit and apple flavours.
- 12. CUVÉE DE L'ECUSSON ROSE Bernard Massard** £25  
Vibrant and juicy rosé offering a beautiful, limpid and shimmering colour. Made of the best Pinot Noir unveiling persistent small red berries and red apple aromas. Delicious!
- 13. CUVÉE DE L'ECUSSON BRUT Bernard Massard** £25  
A meticulous blend of Pinot Blanc, Riesling, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Cellar aged for a minimum of two years to complete its refinement which allows it to develop its typical citrus, pear and grilled almonds aromas and its brioche-buttery notes.
- 14. BRIDE VALLEY, CUVÉE RESERVE** £33  
Pale lemon in colour, the Bride Valley Cuvée Reserve shows green apple and pear with hints of toast to the nose. The palate has a fine nose and lively acidity. The conservative dosage allows the wine to express its natural elegance and freshness.

## CRISP DRY WHITE WINES

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20. **CHENIN BLANC 2014/15, Franschoek Cellar, South Africa** £18  
This wine, in true Chenin character, portrays typical tropical and honey characters with hints of peach and pineapple.
21. **PINOT GRIGIO 2015 Delle Venezie, Carlo Damiani, Fabiano, Italy** £19  
This Pinot Grigio is dry but fruity and well balanced
22. **SANCERRE 2014/15 Domaine de Grande Perrieres, France** £29  
A fine 'steely' Sancerre with all the delicate flavour of the Sauvignon grape, a very open and inviting white wine.

## FRUITY DISTINCTIVE WHITE WINES

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30. **SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA 2015, Apaltagua, Chile** £20  
Fresh, fruity and nicely rounded Sauvignon Blanc, which matches very nicely with seafood, shellfish and goats cheese.
31. **PICPOUL DE PINET 2013, Coteaux du Languedoc, Baron De Badassiere, France** £23  
Pale lemon in colour with a youthful rim. Crisp apple aromas are complemented with a citrus edge. On the palate it has an attractive weight, with a good balance of ripe, yellow plums and greengages and a fresh lime zest acidity that continue through the finish.
32. **SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVE 2014, Black Cottage, New Zealand** £25  
A vibrant nose, full of passion fruit and gooseberries with a lively well balanced palate showing tropical fruit flavours. Refreshing acidity leading to a long lingering finish.
33. **GEWURZTRAMINER 2012/13, Dopff & Irion, France** £25  
Light and soft with an exotic fruit nose. Beautifully perfumed style with broad, rich flavours and a long, fresh aromatic finish.

## SOFT AND ROUNDED WHITE WINES

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40. **CHARDONNAY VIOGNIER 2012, Johnny Q, Australia** £25  
A lively, yet intense Chardonnay Viognier showing some melon and peach fruit flavours from the Chardonnay balanced with some honeysuckle and apricot flavour from the Viognier.
41. **MACON FUISSE 2014, Domaine Thibert, Burgundy, France** £27  
Highly recommended by the Proprietor. This is White Burgundy at its best. All the flavours come together in harmony, wonderful Chardonnay fruit with hints of butter and vanilla. The Thibert have been making Burgundy for generations and practice makes perfect, as is the case here.
42. **PETIT CHABLIS 2014, Jean Durup Château de Maligny, France** £29  
From a selected vineyard site within the Château de Maligny vineyard, this clean, flinty Chablis has incredible concentration of flavour.

## LIGHTER FRUITY RED WINES

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50. **COTES DU RHONE 2013 Colombier, France** £18  
Medium to light-bodied, smooth, with violets and peppery fruit, a good easy to drink style with light berry fruit flavours and soft tannins.
51. **MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 2014, Marchesini, Italy** £19  
Intense ruby red colour with violet on the nose. The flavour is soft and lightly tannic.
52. **FLEURIE 2013 Cru du Beaujolais, Domaine De La Bouroniere, France** £23  
This soft, medium-bodied red is crammed with juicy cherry fruit flavours and aromas.
53. **PINOT NOIR 2013, Black Cottage, Central Otago, New Zealand** £33  
A superb New Zealand Pinot Noir of great purity and finesse. Aromas of strawberry and raspberry with floral undertones and a medium bodied palate. Soft and subtle with fine, lingering tannins.

## MEDIUM-BODIED BALANCED RED WINES

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60. **PINOTAGE 2012/13 Hoopenburg, South-Africa** £19  
Smooth, earthy and packed with blackberry and cherry flavours. Full bodied, tannic and a lovely match for red meats, especially Lamb or Game.
61. **BARBERA D'ALBA 2009 Fratelli Casetta, Piedmonte, Italy** £20  
Fragrant bouquet, with aromas of red and vanilla. The palate has intense black fruit flavours and good length.
62. **MINDIARTE TEMPRANILLO CRIANZA 2011/12 Bodegas Ugarte, Rioja, Spain** £25  
Twelve months in oak, twelve months ageing in the bottle, richly-flavoured and attractively oaky.

## FULLER BODIED RED WINES

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70. **STEEPLE JACK SHIRAZ 2013/14, Ballast Stone Winery, Australia** £19  
A full bodied, and rounded wine with hints of sweetness and spice in the finish.
71. **CARMENERE 2013/14, Huauen, Reserva, Chile** £21  
Wild purple in colour, showing flavours of red and black cherries with smooth tannins and a juicy finish.
72. **PASCUAL TOSO MALBEC 2014, Mendoza, Argentina** £25  
Smooth and beautifully balanced malbec from a top Argentinean producer. The wine has rich black fruit flavours and plenty of body, without having tannins that are too powerful. Great for beef!
73. **URBAN RIBERA 2011, Bodegas Y Vivedos O Fournier, Spain** £27  
A wonderful choice for Rioja lovers with a fragrant bouquet of scorched earth, violets and black cherry that leaps from the glass. Smooth textured and suave on the palate, it has loads of succulent black fruit, silky tannins, excellent depth and grip and a juicy finish.
74. **CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE 2010, Domaine de Nalys, France** £39  
Red fruits, fig and leather notes; supple-mouth feel showing ripe, black fruits flavours and sweet spices; this wine is generous with silky tannins, excellent strength. A very powerful wine!

## BORDEAUX "CLARET"

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80. **CHATEAU FREYBERNAT 2012, Bordeaux Rouge, France** £20  
A fantastic value Bordeaux dominated by a Cabernet Sauvignon, flavours of blackcurrant.
81. **CHATEAU CROIX BLANCHE 2012, St Emilion, France** £23  
A smooth rounded right bank Bordeaux blend dominated by Merlot. A lovely match for Lamb or Duck.
82. **CHATEAU LANDAT AC 2008 Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc** £29  
From this family estate, a rarity in Bordeaux, a classical Médoc wine with more Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend, giving wonderful blackcurrant fruit complexity from the gravel soils and fine integrated tannins from 20% new oak.
83. **CHATEAU LAPELLETRE 2007 Grand Cru, St Emilion** £39  
Firm very oaky claret with ripe blackberry fruit. This wine is 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, a third of the volume aged in new oak casks in old cellars hewn into the rock besides the Chateau.

## ROSE WINES

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90. **ROSE D'ANJOU 2014 Auguste Bonhomme, Loire Valley, France** £20  
Light Salmon in appearance and fruity flavours including strawberry and peach.

- Described by the famous wine critic Robert Parker, as one of the world's best dessert wines, rich, pineapple bouquet, honey and tropical fruits on the palate and a long lingering finish.

## MINI PROSECCO

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- TIAMO PROSECCO, single serve Prosecco 187ml** £6  
Pale light yellow colour, delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes that remind of peach and green apple
